HYMN SING COMING 6/30!

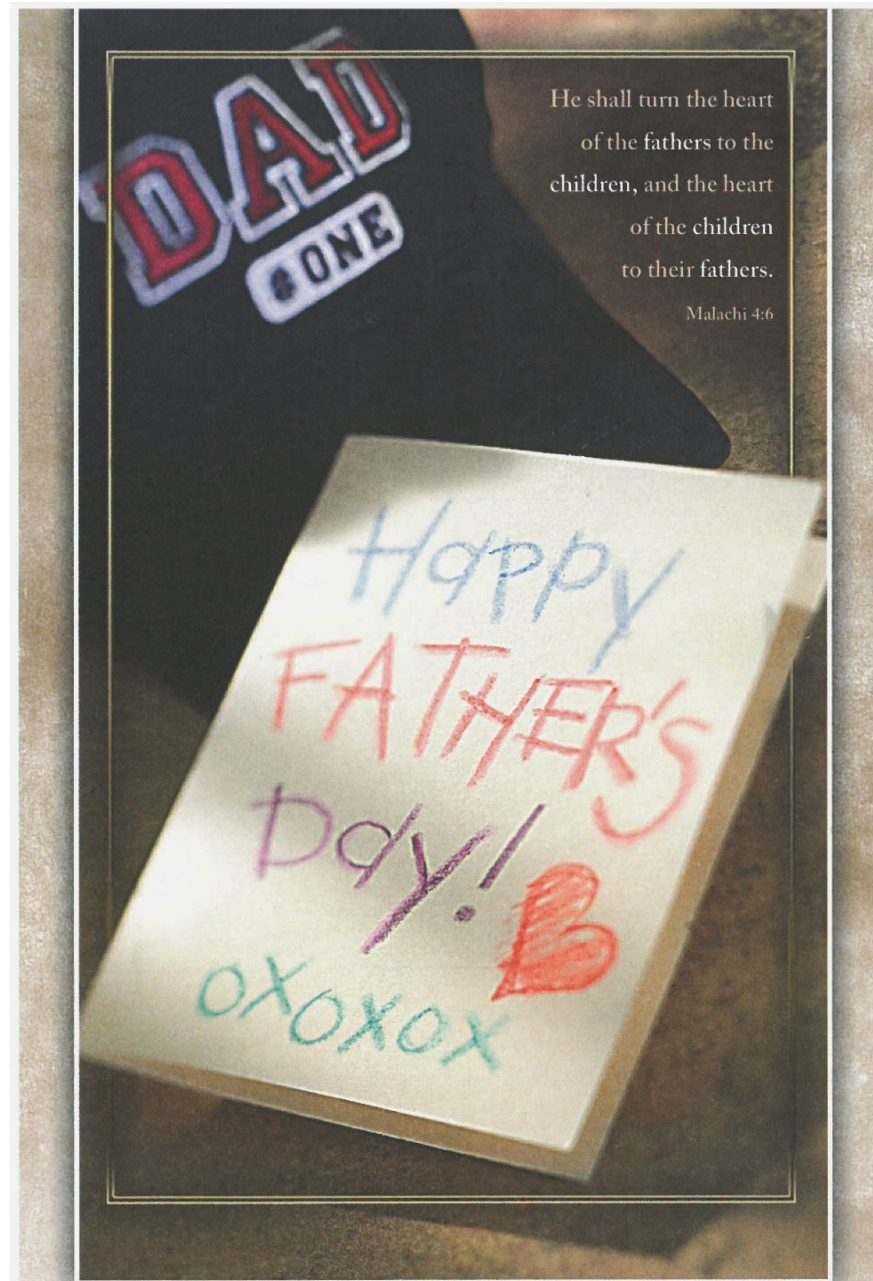
